

## AWGA Caddie Policy

A “caddie” is one who assists the player in accordance with the Rules, which may include carrying or handling the player’s clubs during play.

The following guidelines pertain to caddies in AWGA tournaments:

1. All AWGA tournament fees include a motorized cart. Should the player opt not to use the motorized cart, she will not be entitled to any refund of tournament fees paid.
2. Only the player or her caddie may ride at any one time.
3. When a player’s caddie uses a motorized cart, the following stipulations are in effect under Rule 33-8/4:
  - a. The driver of the cart is the player’s caddie.
  - b. If two players share a cart to transport their clubs, the driver of the cart must be either one of the players, or the caddie of one of the players and he/she may be the caddie of both players.
  - c. If two players share a cart to transport their clubs and each player has her own caddie, either caddie may drive the cart, and the other caddie or the other player may ride in the cart.
  - d. Use of the cart by anyone other than the caddie or caddies or player or players is prohibited.
  - e. If a player has her clubs on a cart, she or her caddie should be riding in the cart.
  - f. Use of the cart by anyone other than the players or caddies is prohibited. If the player or her caddie allows the unauthorized use of her cart, the player is subject to penalty as follows:
    - Two strokes for each hole at which a breach occurred, maximum penalty per round: four strokes. In the event of a breach between the play of two holes, the penalty applies to the next hole.
    - Loss of hole in match play for each hole at which a breach occurred, up to a maximum of two holes per round. In the event of a breach between the play of two holes, the penalty applies to the next hole.
    - Any unauthorized use of the player’s cart must be discontinued immediately upon discovery that a breach has occurred. Otherwise, the player is disqualified.
