



AWGA Spectator Guidelines

Welcome to this AWGA Championship event. We hope you enjoy watching some of the finest amateur women golfers in Arizona. The Committee asks for your cooperation with the following guidelines:

- ❖ Carts are available for spectators, for a fee, at the discretion of the host facility.
- ❖ Spectators (walking or riding in a cart) must stay on the cart paths at all times and stay 30-yards behind the group they are watching. Spectators must also refrain from crossing fairways.
- ❖ Be aware of where you are in relation to all players. Position yourself out of the way for both the players you are watching and those groups around them. Move forward as soon as possible, so players behind can safely hit.
- ❖ We ask that all electronic devices such as cellular phones, pagers or alarm watches be turned off. They are distracting to the players and a breach of the Etiquette code.
- ❖ It is appropriate to encourage players, however, unsolicited and inappropriate comments from spectators is not allowed. Spectators should avoid the appearance of “evil” and may not in any way assist the players, or they will be deemed to be giving advice or “caddying” for the players.
- ❖ Once players have begun to search for a ball spectators may also aid in the search.

PENALTY: The first breach will be a **Warning** to the spectator and player involved.

The second breach will be a **2 Stroke Penalty** to the player involved.

A further breach will be turned over to the Committee in Charge of the competition.
